OFFICIAL RULES

1. There is a \$20 non-refundable entry fee for all players.
2. There is a \$5 donation to switch out a tile.
3. There will be a 2 minute limit per turn as measured by provided sand timers.
4. Prize to be awarded to winner: 50% of entry fees. Further prizes will be awarded for highest single word score and lowest game score.
5. We will do our best to honor place and day preferences on your entry form, but it will be your responsibility to work out with your opponent the time and place that will work for both of you.
6. You will be required to play approximately one match per week throughout the duration of the tournament.
7. If you fail to show up for your appointed match, your opponent automatically will be declared the winner and will advance to the next round. Your entry fee will not be refunded.
8. The final four players will be required to play their championship matches at the tournament closing party (date TBD) at The Spotty Dog. There will be spectators, cocktails, and general merriment in the room as you play.
9. Official Scrabble rules as included with Scrabble sets will be followed.
10. Official references will be The Official SCRABBLE® Players Dictionary, Fourth Edition as the word source. The Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary, Eleventh Edition, will be the reference for words with more than 8 letters.
11. You may not use the above references or any others while playing your turn. They are for challenges only.
12. Any disputes will be settled by the bartender at The Spotty Dog, or the Director or on-duty staff member or volunteer at the Library. All decisions are final and no disputes will be heard.
13. All Scrabble games will be signed out and signed back in with staff at the Library or The Spotty Dog. Games must be returned in the condition in which they were received. Should damage or missing pieces be discovered on return or prior to next use, person who signed out the game will be responsible.
14. Score sheets will be turned in to the bartender at The Spotty Dog or filed in the Scrabble envelope at the Library circulation desk. Score sheets must be filled out completely and initialed by both players.
