Computer Area Code of Conduct

Computer Area users are expected to observe the Hudson Area Library (HAL) general code of conduct.

The computer area is solely for the use of the computer.

- Only those using a public computer are allowed in the computer area.
- Only one person at a computer at one time.

Computer use is limited.

- Patrons must use their own library card to log onto computers.
- Visitors with photo ID may request a visitor pass at the front desk for computer usage.
- The use of computers is limited to one hour per day per patron.
- When all computers are in use, you may add your name to the queue by bringing your library card to the front desk.
- The cost to print a page is \$0.25 each; all printing charges must be paid in advance at the front desk.

The computer area must be quiet, safe and comfortable for all patrons' use.

- No food or drink is allowed in the computer area.
- The display of sexually explicit material is inappropriate for a public, open environment and is prohibited.
